DIANE REMY is affiliated with and has taught on the faculties of Dance Masters of Wisconsin, Chicago National Association of Dance Masters, Cecchetti Council of America Midwest Branch where she holds a Grade Five classical ballet teacher rating and has taught for National Association of Dance and Affiliated Arts. Diane has performed throughout the Midwest and at Jacob’s Pillow and with the Racine Dance Theater. She received her early training with Helen Finst, Vesper Chamberlin, and Tibor Zana.
