### FACULTY BIOS

**JULIA TEHVEN-SUTTON** has danced professionally in the Twin Cities for more than 20 years; performing with the Minnesota Dance Theatre, Ballet of the Dolls, and the James Sewell Ballet. Julia received her dance training with the Minnesota Dance Theatre, studying the Russian Vaganova technique, and Loyce Houlton's own contemporary technique of blending classical ballet and modern dance. She has brought both of these disciplines to her classes at the Wirth Performing Arts Center, Zenon School, Larkin Dance, and Dance Spectrum. Julia is a recipient of the McKnight Dancer Fellowship Award and is currently training in the Stott method of Pilates.

**ANNE GOLLENBERG**, originally from New York, graduated from Point Park University with a B. A. in Dance. Directly following graduation she traveled to Chicago to study at the Giordano Dance Center within the Scholarship program, as well as with River North. Anne has performed in numerous Chicago venues, throughout the United States, and traveled to Madrid, Spain for the 31<sup>st</sup> annual Choreographers Showcase. Ms. Gollenberg is currently Associate Artistic Director, Business Manager, and founding company dancer for Inside Chicago Dance, now in its eighth successful year. She is also the Director of the North Shore Junior Repertory Dance Ensemble at the North Shore School of Dance. Anne is on faculty at many Chicago-land studios, enjoys master teaching, and setting choreography throughout the country.

**HEATHER BROWN**, St. Charles, MO, is in her 2nd season with BAM! Heather has had the opportunity to perform at the International Dance Festival in Beijing, China, and throughout Chicago and the Midwest in such venues as the Harris Theater and the Pritzker Pavilion in Chicago's Millennium Park. As an individual artist, she has performed at the Joyce Theatre in NYC with the NYC Tap Festival and as a guest artist with local dance companies in different venues, including jazz clubs in St. Louis. While living in St. Louis, Heather taught tap classes and private lessons at several dance studios. Heather graduated from Webster University in St. Louis where she received her B. A. in Marketing and a minor in dance.

### DMW POLICIES TO BE OBSERVED BY ALL IN ATTENDANCE

#### CELL PHONE/VIDEOS/PHOTOS

If you need to use your cell phone, please use it outside the dance rooms during breaks. Cell phones need to be out-of-sight and turned off or in silent mode and may not be used in the dance rooms.

Only registered members may video tape. Please check at the registration desk for names of faculty granting permission to tape. Tapings may be used for educational purposes only.

Due to choreographic and copyright infringements, parents (or others) are NOT allowed to video tape; even if it is just of their individual child.

Photos may not be taken during classes with the exception of the official DMW photographer.

#### OBSERVER POLICY

Observers must be non-dance affiliated.

ALL observers will pay the required fees unless specifically excused by the constitution.

Observers are only allowed in student dance rooms.

**ABSOLUTELY NO OBSERVERS ALLOWED IN THE TEACHER'S ROOM** even when senior students are participating in that room.

#### ROOM DESIGNATION

Students may only participate in the room for which they are registered.

Students may NOT visit and/or participate in other classrooms.

Teachers and assistants may visit other classrooms, BUT **MAY NOT DANCE IN THOSE ROOMS.**

#### DRESS CODE

ALL DANCERS must wear a leotard and tights.

No bare midriffs, street clothes, or bulky clothing which conceal body line.

Secure ALL hair off face and neck.

Dance shoes, appropriate to dance discipline, are required.

A cover-up is required when leaving the dance area.
