Faculty Bios

Zebbi Allison grew up dancing in Madison under the instruction of Virginia Lee Mackesey. She has been a member of Dance Masters of Wisconsin for 30 years. Although Zebbi has advanced training in ballet, tap and jazz, her forte is tap. She teaches advanced tap and jazz teacher at Premier Dance Academy. She was a member of Jazzworks for many years, including serving as their co-director for a year. She has been very active in the community, choreographing for Edgewood High School's theater department, as well as Middleton Players Theater and Children's Theater of Madison. Zebbi has been inducted into Edgewood High School's Hall of Fame, and recently she became an inductee in DMW's Hall of Fame. In addition to teaching dance, Zebbi works full time for NET Technology. She has two sons, CJ and Damon, and a daughter, Kennedy, who is a Premier Dance Academy graduate and now a faculty member at Premier Dance Academy.

Ashley Harty's passion for dance started at the young age of 4 at the Dance Arts Center in Racine, WI. As a member of the Competitive Company, she earned numerous titles and scholarships, including the significant \$50,000 scholarship to the American Musical and Dramatic Academy (AMDA), a prestigious performing arts conservatory in New York and Los Angeles. Ashley pursued her college education at University Wisconsin - Platteville, where she received a Bachelor's of Science in Biology and Forensic Investigation. She was also a dedicated member of their Collegiate Dance Team. After graduation, Ashley was invited back to showcase a self-choreographed piece with the concert band. Ashley has taught at various studios across Wisconsin, sharing her love of dance with countless students. She has also performed in numerous musicals, including A Chorus Line with the Lancaster Community Players, and is currently a member of Madison Contemporary Dance Company. Ashley is currently working towards her certification with Dance Masters of Wisconsin and is YAPD certified.

Heather Sullivan has been dancing since 1986 and has been teaching since 1998. She became a member of Dance Masters of Wisconsin in 2000 and is certified to teach Ballet, Jazz, and Tap. Over the years Heather has studied a variety of dance forms, including Ballet, Contemporary, Hawaiian/Hula, Hip Hop, Jazz, Lyrical, Pointe, and Tap. She has been attending DMW dance conventions for the past 29 years and has had the opportunity to be inspired by countless instructors over the years. The insights gained and the friendships formed at dance conventions and in classes is something you carry with you throughout your life! She enjoys working with students of all ages, but teens and adults hold a special place in her heart. Heather is currently an instructor (and a life-long student) at 5-6-7-8 Dance Studio in Janesville. While she teaches a variety of classes, she has become known as the "ballet" teacher due to her enjoyment in teaching it both as an artistic expression as well as a physical and mental challenge. Heather is blessed with a beautiful family - husband Mike (18 years); sons Christian (8), Lochlan (7), and Griffin (5). She is a proud stay-at-home mother who also teaches middle school Spanish and a few other Junior High classes at her church's Christian day school.

Miranda Zielinski began training in dance at Nancy Dianne Studio of Dance, Ltd at the age of 3 and continued on until graduating from Germantown High School. During her 15 years at the Studio she studied Ballet, Tap, Jazz, and Modern Dance and in her High School years participated in the Student Teaching Apprenticeship Program. She was also given the opportunity to work with New York visual artist, Xavier Cha and Chicago based choreographer Molly Shanahan.
