Faculty Bios

Desmond Cotton is a native of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He started his dance training at Milwaukee High School of the Arts (MHSA), where he had the opportunity to train under Roxanne Kess, Dean Drews, Sandra Jordan, and Amie Ferrante. Cotton went on to pursue a Bachelor's of Fine Arts Degree in contemporary dance and performance choreography at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee; thereby, studying under Simone Linhares Ferro, Maria Gillespie, Danielle Kuepper, and Ferne Bronson. Cotton is so blessed to have had the opportunity to teach many young dancers, especially those from Wisconsin. He has even taught at a plethora of schools, which include Thurston Woods Campus, Henry David Thoreau Elementary School, Benjamin Franklin School, MacDowell Montessori School, Parkview School, River Trail School, Lincoln Center of the Arts, Roosevelt Middle School of the Arts, Milwaukee High School of the Arts, and many more. For he believes youth is the future, and talent is forever. Currently, Cotton is a senior company member with Ko-Thi Dance Company.

Tom Kilps is a native of Madison, Wisconsin, where he received his early dance training from Studio One, Monona Academy of Dance, Ballet Madison, and Madison Ballet. He furthered his education at Pittsburgh Ballet Theater School, The Rock School, and Houston Ballet's Ben Stevenson Academy before joining Texas Ballet Theater in 2003. Throughout his career with TBT, Tom performed numerous roles in Ben Stevenson's ballets, including "Ptolemy" in Cleopatra, "Renfield" in Dracula, "White Rabbit" in Alice in Wonderland, "Mercutio" in Romeo and Juliet, "Amour" in Don Quixote, and "Jester" in Cinderella. Tom retired from full-time dancing with TBT in 2015 due to chronic injuries but continued dancing guest roles with the Fort Worth Opera, The Dallas Opera, and Contemporary Ballet Dallas before relocating to Wisconsin in 2016 to be closer to family. He now runs Dance Jox full-time and occasionally performs character roles as a guest artist with Madison Ballet.

Sophie Sullivan is a dancer and choreographer from Waukegan, Illinois. She began her training at the age of 3 at Rhythm Academy of Dance, until the age of 18 when she moved to Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Prior to her move, her focus was immersing herself into as many dance styles as possible as well as competing both individually and on teams. Since her move, her focus has shifted to performing and teaching. She currently teaches at various studios throughout Wisconsin and was a director of a hip hop crew in Milwaukee called SAINTS. Some of her highlights include placing third at World of Dance Chicago 2021, achieving best theme at World of Dance Chicago 2021 and 2022, competing at World of Dance world finals 2022 and 2023, Wisconsin Sports Awards, Summerfest, Pridefest, Bucks halftime shows and various concerts at Turner Hall. While she loves to be on stage, her true passion is connecting with and inspiring others.

Sam Weber is an award winning artist whose reputation in the world of tap dance spans the globe. Sam is in demand internationally as a performer, master teacher and choreographer. A protege of tap master Stan Kahn in San Francisco, he was a principal dancer and choreographer with the Jazz Tap Ensemble from 1986 to 2009 and received acclaim at home and abroad touring with the company. Sam has appeared at international tap festivals since the first Colorado Tap Festival in 1986 and has taught and performed alongside such legendary tap masters as Charles "Honi" Coles, Jimmy Slyde, Steve Condos, Buster Brown, Gregory Hines and the Nicholas Brothers. Sam is one of the few tap dancers in the world who performs Morton Gould's "Tap Dance Concerto." He was the first tap dancer to receive New York's "Bessie" award, presented in recognition of outstanding artistic achievement, and he is also the recipient of numerous tap dance awards, including Legacy Awards from the Orange County Tap Fest and the Third Coast Rhythm Project, the Juba Award from the Chicago Human Rhythm Project and the Hoofers Award from the American Tap Dance Foundation and a lifetime achievement award from Chicago Dance Masters. He has taught at UCLA, Cal State U. Fullerton, Cal State U., L.A. and San Francisco State University. He teaches regular classes in San Francisco.
